2. This meeting was not attended by Ms. Nisha Oraon, Member and Shri Nitish Kumar Singh, Member Secretary, State Finance Commission. Special Invitee Director, Municipal Administration was not present due to his meeting in Government of India but his representative Ms. Abhilasha Kumari was present.

3. 5th State Finance Commission so far met on different date to discuss different issues pertaining to Terms of Reference of State Finance Commission. 4. Financial Allocation through Jharkhand Contingency Fund was made available in May, 2024 to SFC but due to unresolved issue of Drawing & Disbursing Officer, the drawal started only in July, 2024. Even salary was made available in July/August, 2024 to Chairman and one Member first time. The salary of members is still pending since July, 2024 due to non-availability of allotment under the concern head. This issue was not taken up in the 1st Supplementary Budget. Again, efforts are being made to get Budget provision for the same through other admissible mechanism. The SFC Secretariat is requested to be more proactive on these issues and may develop a better coordination mechanism to not avoid such situation in future.

5. Inadequate working space for the functioning of State Finance Commission is still an unresolved issue. Although with availability of current rooms, State Finance Commission is functioning with support of Department of Planning & Development and few deputed staff by Finance Department who are burdened with their original work. These deputed staff & officers are trying their level best to assist the State Finance Commission. But the smooth functioning of State Finance Commission is affected frequently. The scheduled meetings are not being organized in due time and are being cancelled. The letters are not being issued in time. Most of the letters are being written by the Chairman or members of State Finance Commission under hand and then its being get typed by deputed person. The deputed officers are trying their level best to complete the work at the earliest but they are finding it difficult to meet the timeline.

- (ii) Sanction of posts for State Finance Commission is in the process.
- (iii) No PPS/PA, No landline phone, No computer etc. are still made available whereas inspite almost 6 months have passed after 1st meeting of the State Finance Commission held in March, 2024.

6. A positive development has happened that for the creation of new portal for State Finance Commission, order has been issued to National Informatics Centre, (NIC), Ranchi for the same vide letter No. 135/वि०आ०, dated 16.08.2024. NIC is starting the work soon after completing necessary formalities.

7. The procurement of necessary equipment can be processed only after GEM Portal Registration get completed. Member Secretary is looking the issue and discussing with persons concerned. This is reported that matter is pending in the Finance Department.

- (ii) Department of Finance on the request of State Finance Commission has already constituted the Purchase Committee vide letter No.75/वि०, dated 09.05.2024.
- (iii) Member Secretary was given the responsibility as Chairman, Purchase Committee.

8. Member of the Commission has been allotted a vehicle on official use on 29.06.2024.

9. Field visit was not possible yet due to lack of adequate secretariat support. All letters/proceedings etc. are being prepared by Chairman & Member, Shri Harishwar Dayal only.

10. The departments have not responded to letters & reminders send to them since April/May 2024. The General Election/ Lok Sabha 2024 and transfer of few officers may have affected this process. This need to be expedited. Few departments have responded as mentioned below:

HSE 49

- (i) Department of Road Construction responded vide letter No. 3329, dated 16.08.2024. This was accepted. Department of Road Construction made it clear that the department is not related to Panchayati Raj Institution & Urban Local Bodies.
- (ii) Department of Water Resources Department vide letter No. 267 dated 18.06.2024 had responded. The said letter was replied vide letter No. 92, dated 24.06.2024. There is no response received so far.
- (iii) Department of Planning & Development had responded vide letter No. 714 dated 14.06.2024 & letter No. 759 dated 26.06.2024. State Finance Commission had requested vide letter no. 111, dated 03.07.2024. No reply has been received so far.
- (iv) Department of Forest, Environment & Climate Change (EE & CC) vide letter No. 34 dated 27-08-2024 informed that the department is in process of delegating the powers mentioned in 11th & 12th Schedule of 73rd & 74th amendment of Constitution respectively.
- (v) The department is being requested to provide the status of road network of rural area which connect state Headquarter-District and District-Block and any network which connects Block-Gram Panchayat and same about urban area network. The density of road vis-à-vis national average. Road network are the pillar of development process. The departments may share the expenditure of the department Financial Year 2010-11 to Financial year 2023-24 with coverage in urban/rural separately.
- (vi) 5th State Finance Commission has requested several department to submit/share information on several subjects beside points mentioned above, no reply has been received. The brief is mentioned below:

11. **List of Nodal Officers received by the SFC** Earlier it was informed by the section that some details received but the section is not able to track them now. This may be collected again. A letter may be send to concerned department to get such information. A list may be created and a meeting may be arranged soon with the nodal officer. A letter may be issued under the signature of the Secretary 5th SFC to the department and someone may coordinate on phone too.

12. **Delegation of Financial Power:** This comes to notice that MS is having multiple important assignments in the Finance Department. This makes it difficult to devote adequate time to SFC. Although SFC is having major constraints of availability of human resources till now. This is affecting the work of the commission. In consultation with the member and following decision are taken to improve the functioning and reduce the pendency of SFC office.

13. (a) **DDO will have following power :**
- (i) Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) for the purpose of office expense, material Purchase and vehicle expense on the meeting of SFC etc.
 - (ii) Any expenditure fixed as admissible to office bearer of 5th SFC by the Finance Department/

HSZ 1-

Cabinet and Vigilance Deptt. eg fuel limit for vehicle, mobile phone, internet bill, purchase/reimbursement of new phone etc.

14. (a) **Deputy Secretary:** (i) Rs. 50000/- (Fifty thousand) for any purpose as mentioned in 12(a), (i), (ii) any necessary item on proper requisition by SFC staff under counter signed by member.
15. **Rest:** As Exist now.

Note: (i) The existing letter of Finance Department and any subsequent amendment on the above subject will be taken into account and finance department has issued order about expenditure and purchase up to 1,50,000/- (one lakh fiity thousand) implemented accordingly, which must be followed by above authorities with delegated power.

(ii) TDS/IT,GST/VAT, Labour cess etc will be implement as applicable by the different notification of GoJ.

(iii) All copy of sanction order will be put up via MS for perusal on regular basis (at least monthly once)

(iv) Vouchers will be passed by the respective officers up to that limit on the individual item basis.

(iv) For any emergency /urgent work if any, person is employed for few days , then he/she will be paid as the rate notified by the Department of Labour Employment and Skill Development GoJ for the said working period. Member/MS will act on these urgencies.

16. The representative of Department of Urban Development & Housing, Jharkhand has briefed on the submission of Memorandum. They are planning to do it in house with the help of young and dynamic officers with 2-5 years experience whereas Department of Panchayati Raj is engaging expert organization like IIM etc. Urban Development and Planning is more complex and challenging in the state of Jharkhand.

17 **Following points emerged in the discussion:**


18. (i) The Department of Urban Development and Housing was represented by Ms. Abhilasha Kumari, Assistant Director, and Directorate of Municipal Administration.

(ii) She said that a team of officers in the department is working on memorandum under the direction of Jt. Secretary, Mr. Deepak Kumar Dubey, IAS and under Secretary, Mr. Atul Kumar.

(iii) She also informed that the Chairman and the member of the commission about the development made so far.

- (iv) She was asked by the Chairman to collect information on environmental sustainability of the urban areas, the efforts done by the Department and the Municipal Administration for the necessary green cover of the urban areas and how the six waste management rules are being implemented and what its status in the state is in general and municipal areas in particular.
- (v) She was also asked to collect information on the sources of OSR (Own Source of Revenue) of the urban bodies year wise data of the total collection and the operational cost of the urban local bodies and existing deficit if any, and mechanism exist to cover the deficit in administrative establishment cost (Salary/Pension etc) other cost separately.
- (vi) A detailed note about on line public grievances redressal system and mechanism of transparency adopted by the integrated system at state level or ULBs level and its status of today and upgradation proposed, if any.
- (vii) Training system of Elected Representative and newly recruited staff and skill upgradation of existing staff on regular basis. If not existing, or not adequate then steps to be purposed to upgrade the existing system or create a new system.
- (viii) Status of Jharkhand Right to Service Act in Urban Local Bodies may be reviewed and a status report may be brought to State Finance Commission.


