Sub:- Status of delegation of powers to PRI as matters listed in Schedule 11 of the 73rd constitutional amendment and constituted part of the Jharkhand Panchayat Raj Act, 2001 and its subsequent amendments – regarding.

SFC has received your letter as mentioned above. At the outset, I thank you for updating the information. SFC has taken a view to understand the level of coordination amongst the different departments which are involved in the similar activities. This was also part of the letter which is being reproduced below.

“The Department is further requested to incorporate in this report the delegation of power to PRIs and best practices in other 5th Scheduled States like Chhatisgarh, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Himachal Pradesh, Rajasthan, Odisha, Andhra Pradesh and Telangana. It is important to note that there are certain activities among the 29 items that are being covered by more than one department. The department, in this report, is also requested to point out the same along with the established practices of coordination with other departments.”

I request you to update the SFC on the following points:

1. No poverty has several dimensions under SDG 2030. This may be collectively being monitored at your level. So, please indicate the level of coordination. May like to share the list of schemes being implemented departmentwise which are aimed to reduce the poverty or aimed to achieve the first SDG goal.
2. Please share the progress report of SDG goals year wise of Jharkhand and level of the monitoring of these goals. May indicate progress of Jharkhand Vs National progress and or with neighbouring state of Bihar and Orissa.
3. I have come to know that Chhatisgarh has established a robust monitoring mechanism for SDG. Is the department interested to understand the same and put similar or better mechanism if it has not been taken any shape yet. UNDP is normally extending support to state government for such initiatives.
